Art in East Park is held annually in conjunction with Zumbrota's Covered Bridge Music and Arts Festival featuring Kid's Games, Food Vendors, Sport Tourney's, Flea Market, a Grand Parade, Street Dance and much, much more!!! Our venue is held in the beautiful and relaxing East Park, located on East Avenue, between 6th and 7th Streets.

ENTRY & FEES: Each space is 10X10, \$45.00 per space. To enter, detach **entry form** and submit with **3 pictures**, a brief **resume** (if available), copy of Sales Tax **Permit** on a full sheet of paper (if new applicant) and a **check** made payable to Z.A.A.C. Last year's exhibitors need not submit pictures, resume or Sales Tax Certificate unless requested. *Deadline for entry: when full.*

PICTURES: Three pictures must show examples of the type of work the exhibitor plans to exhibit and sell. All entries will be juried. Our jury reserves the right to reject any work for reasons of balance, appropriateness or limited space. Mark each picture with artist's name. Pictures will not be returned.

CANCELLATION POLICY: If accepted into the Zumbrota Arts Festival it is considered a commitment to exhibit. Your fee will not be refunded in the event you cancel after May 18th. Inclement weather will not entitle the entrant to a refund.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to fine arts and quality crafts. The artist must execute all works on display.

EXHIBITED WORK: If work exhibited on the day of the festival is not of the same nature as that submitted to our jury, the artist would be asked to remove such items from display with no refund of entry fee.

SALES TAX: Exhibitor is responsible for collection and payment of Minnesota Sales Tax. New applicants must provide us with a copy of their Sales Tax Permit or Confirmation Letter. Include a copy with your entry form.

LIABILITY: Sponsor will exercise all reasonable precautions. However, exhibitors shall indemnify and hold harmless the Zumbrota Covered Bridge Music and Arts Festival, the City of Zumbrota, Zumbrota Area Arts Council, staff and volunteers against any and all loss or damage to their works of arts and crafts and property.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Complimentary refreshments will be served to exhibitors from 8:00 to 10:00 a.m. Food/beverages will be sold during the day. Restrooms are on the grounds. No sales commissions are charged. Exhibitors will be expected to fill out and hand in a critique prior to leaving the festival. Electrical hook-up is not available for exhibitors. Do not bring pets. If you have any special needs or requests please indicate this on your entry form

SET-UP & TEAR-DOWN: Set-up may begin at 6:00 p.m. the night before the festival at your own risk. Tear down must not occur before 4:00 p.m. Vehicles may not enter park for tear down until most of the shopping crowd has left the park and an event organizer has announced it is time for vehicle entry into the park. Exhibit space must be left trash free.
