<u>Budget</u> - Quarterly budget information from Accountant Dave Zimmerman was handed out by Smith and a further synopsis was prepared by Marx.

<u>State Theatre Management Committee</u> - Smith reported on discussions under way. A new rental policy for the theatre is under discussion.

Volunteer coordinator Candy Marx resigned from the job a week ago after three years. She will be recognized as the volunteer of the year.

Some new volunteer training is under way and tests for bartenders have been scheduled. Anne Storey will be assigning bartenders.

There were some problems with the apartment that are being worked out. Kevin Kish helped to resolve problems. The renter is moving in this week.

Recycling has been a problem.

Plans for Ole and Lena are in place and being advertised. Posters will be received this week.

Encore Fundraising - Part 2 - Kish reported that \$2,000 was received from the Zumbrota Community Trust.
