Committee reports:

Art on Main - No details for 2018, but it is in the planning stages.

<u>Art Splash</u> - Weather was cooperative and artists were happy with attendance and sales. It will be planned again for 2018, with Lomen still in charge. There is some expense for advertising, but well worth it. The event is good for ZAAC and for the community.

State Theatre

<u>Building Project Update</u> - Work is continuing with a completed outcome expected soon. Tiles have been purchased and will be laid soon.

<u>Theatre Management Committee</u> - Smith talked about membership on the management committee.

Several new members have been added. They are Judy Lang and Linda Kazmierczak. Membership also includes Roxanne Bartsch, Linda Smith, Gary Grover, Anne Storey and Stacy Drenckhahn, who also was added at a later time after the committee was established. Because the ZAAC board established the committee and set the

membership, board members felt it was necessary for the board to approve new committee members.

Smith moved, Lomen 2nd approval of the new committee membership. Passed unanimously.

Merle Edel is exploring options for a cash register and will report to the committee.

<u>Discussion of board member concerns</u> - The committee discussed concerns mentioned by the board and explained why they made decisions that resulted in those concerns.
