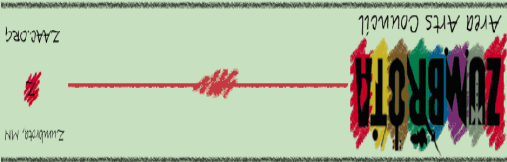
Music in the Park - *select Tuesdays*

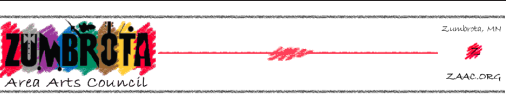

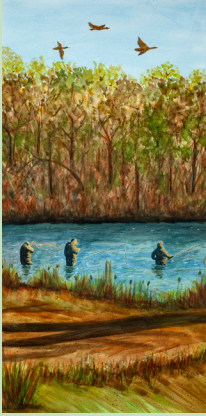

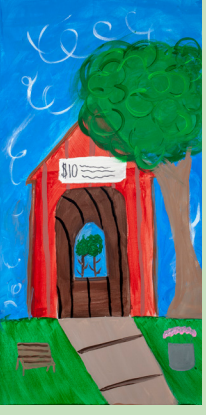
