

Zumbrota Area Arts Council board minutes, June 6th, 2022

Members present in person and via Zoom: Bill Marx, Linda Smith, Kevin Klapperich, Billy Wendt, Janice Carr. Members not present: Roxanne Bartsh.

Meeting called to order at 7:00PM

April minutes approved, motion by Billy, second by Linda.

Treasurer's report: Kevin gave treasurer report, current checkbook balance \$48,369.72

Membership report: Bill announced that the membership remains stable at 76 members.

Theatre report: Roxanne was not able to attend in person so emailed board members theatre updates.

Music in the Park report: Janice reported that Music in the Park starts Tuesday night and would welcome any help with setup and takedown. Janice has collected from several sponsors already while others have mailed their payments.

Art on Main: The banners are up. Linda is working through identifying artists based on the information that Mary left. Art submissions are getting fewer over the last 2-3 years so we may skip a year or find a way to change it up to attract more participants.

Youth Art Contest: 38 total art pieces have been submitted. Art will be posted on the website so the judges can pick the winners in each category and the people's choice award.

Songs of Hope is scheduled to perform at the theatre on July 21st. The students will be staying at the Catholic church and other churches are arranging picnic meals. 35 students are expected to participate.

Bill discussed that we are getting short on ZAAC brochures and will order 300 more from Theis Printing in Zumbrota.

Welcome Services renewal is due with a cost of \$108/yr. Jan motioned and Kevin seconded, motion carried to pay for the renewal.

The covered bridge festival committee is looking for a non-profit to take on the fiscal management of the town festival and has asked if ZAAC had any interest. After discussion it was decided to decline.
