Volunteers

ZAAC is successful only because it has many volunteers. About 55 people volunteered to assist with ZAAC activities in 2023. Many of those people volunteered for various activities at the State Theatre. However, volunteers also make Music in the Park, the Youth Art Contest, Art on Main and the Allan Nilson Memorial ZAAC scholarship happen.

ZAAC Volunteers

- Volunteer responsibilities at theatre events include making and selling popcorn, selling concessions and selling wine and beer.
- Volunteers sell tickets at ZAAC events.
- Volunteers order supplies, do repair work and help with major projects at the Theatre.
- Volunteers organize Music in the Park.
- ZAAC needs more volunteers for the State Theatre and other activities.

ZAAC Sponsored Activities

- Music in the Park Ten Tuesdays in June, July and early August in 2023.
- Art on Main No new banners in 2023 but previous year's banners were up on Main Street in June 2023.
- Scholarship for a Zumbrota-Mazeppa graduating senior.
- Youth Art Contest June 2023. The 2023 event was online. Art was displayed on the ZAAC web site.
- Songs of Hope ZAAC has sponsored the Songs of Hope group to perform a concert in Zumbrota for a number of years. Youth from a variety of countries sign some of the music from those countries. That conert was July 20 in 2023.

Music in the Park

- Weekly summer concerts by popular regional artists held in the band shell at East Park on Tuesday evenings in June, July and August.
- Ten concerts were held in 2023 that included jazz, folk, country, bluegrass and rock.
- Attendance averaged about 135 people per concert.
- Free ice cream bars are passed out by volunteers.
- The concerts are organized by ZAAC and sponsored by local businesses.

Art on Main

- ZAAC sponsored the Art on Main banner project every year 2013 2022 (except for 2017).
- Artists donated their artwork and a banner displaying the art is hung on Main Street in early June.
- Banners displaying the art were sponsored by local businesses.
- Art on Main was not be held in 2023. Banners from previous years were donated to the city to be reused. Those banners were hung on the lamp posts on Main Street in 2023.

Other Art Activities

- A free youth art workshop was held in 2023 with pre-registration required. Due to a snowstorm only three area youth participated.
- The Zumbrota Watercolorists displayed art at the Zumbrota Library.
- Many people participated in the art activity at the ZAAC booth in Covered Bridge Park during the Covered Bridge Festival.

Youth Art Contest

- The Youth Art Contest was held online again in June 2023 with the art posted on the ZAAC website. In 2023, 24 youth artists submitted 44 pieces of artwork.
- Youth art is solicited through ads in the local newspaper and through teachers in local schools.
- The youth art is judged by age group (five groups) and prizes are awarded to winners in each age category.
- A Youth Art Contest is not planned for 2024.
 ZAAC needs to re-establish a youth art activity.

ZAAC Graduating Senior Scholarship

- ZAAC awards a \$500 scholarship to a graduating senior who has excelled in various forms of art throughout their years in the Zumbrota-Mazeppa Schools.
- Special consideration is placed on the individual's sharing of their talents and gifts within the context of the community at large.
- The 2023 recipient was Kyle Moyer.
- Recent recipients were Sheridan Wilson in 2022, Soren Hellyer in 2021, Abigal Voss in 2020, Emily Haugen in 2019, Cooper Utely in 2018, Bethany Renken in 2017, and Alec Hunstad in 2016.
- The ZAAC Board has named this scholarship the Allan Nilson Memorial ZAAC Scholarship.

State Theatre

- ZAAC purchased the State Theatre in December 2011 and began operating it in April 2012.
- The building was constructed in 1921. It opened September 28, 1921. 2021 was the 100th anniversary of the Theatre opening.
- The Theatre was closed from March 2020 until September 2021 due to Covid. Events were held again beginning in fall 2021.
- Current seating capacity is 264.

State Theatre – 2023 Activity

- In 2023 the Theatre has held 33 public events including concerts, movies and Z-Theatre plays. About 2,600 individuals attended these events.
- The Theatre was also used for various meetings and play rehearsals.
- ZAAC has established a Theatre Management Committee for management of the State Theatre. The Theatre Committee is looking for additional members. If interested please contact Roxanne Bartsh.

State Theatre – Projects Completed Since ZAAC Purchased the Building

- Replaced the roof and a number of windows, installed a new air conditioner.
- Built the new addition with handicapped accessible bathrooms and a new concessions area.
- Upgraded the backstage area with a bathroom, green room and more stage access.
- Installed a water proofing system in the basement.
- Auditorium lighting and sound system have been upgraded.
- Repaired and repainted the auditorium ceiling.
- Completed some electrical upgrades.
- Upgrades to the upstairs apartment.

State Theatre Projects - 2023

- Seats removed from Theatre, refurbished, and re-installed in summer 2023.
- Sound board, lighting controls and projection controls moved to center back of the auditorium while seats were out.
- Major stucco repair on the building exterior (repainting to occur in 2024).

State Theatre – Plans for the Future

- Remodel the Theatre lobby in 2021 we hired an architectural firm to design plans for the lobby.
 They have been working with Benike
 Construction to assess structural needs for the project. We are working with Benike to refine the project and begin construction this summer.
- Complete upgrades to the electrical system in the building.
- Restore the historic mural in the theatre lobby.
